Creates The Increment

Has the authority to create the Increment

Prerogative Quality

Has the authority to ensure that the work is high quality

Prerogative

Estimation

Has the authority to estimate the work

Prerogative

Work Breakdown

Has the authority to determine how the work is to be done

Delivering The Increment

Does the work of delivering a potentially releasable Increment

Estimation

Estimates the work

Forecast

Forecasts the work to be done based on past performance

Product Backlog Refinement

Assists the Product Owner with refining the Product Backlog. But no more than 10% of their capacity.

Engineering Practices

Improve the engineering practices used by the Development Team

Characteristic Self Organising

Self organising and no one tells them how to do the work

Cross Functional

Cross functional with all of the skills needed in the team

Characteristic One Team

One mutally accountable team with no sub teams created or recognised

Cross Functional

A group of experts in their own field that work together as a single team

Characteristic Size

Have no fewer than 3 and no more than 9 members

Developers

Are called "Developers" irrespective of their area of expertise

Prerogative

Owns The Product Backlog

Has the authority to take ownership of the Product Backlog

Prerogative Scope

Has the authority to define the scope of the product

Prerogative

Release

Has the authority to decide when to release

Prerogative

Independent Authority

Has indepdendent authority over the product

Optimise Value

Optimises the value created by the Development Team

Understanding

Ensures that the Development Team understand the items in the Product Backlog

Ordering

Responsible for changing the order of items in the Product Backlog

Product Backlog Items

Clearly expresses Product Backlog Items

Transparency

Ensuring that the Product Backlog is clear and visible to all

Single Person

Is a single person and not a group or committee

Thinks conceptually about the product and the vision

Interaction

Interacts with the Development
Team as often as possible to help
achieve the best value

Characteristic Empathy

Has a good sense of empathy for the end users and their needs

Characteristic Strategic Thinking

Thinks strategically about the end product and what is needed to satisfy the needs

Prerogative Scrum

Has the authority to ensure that the Scrum team adheres to the Scrum theory, practices and rules

Prerogative Scrum

Has the authority to ensure that Scrum is understood and enacted

Prerogative

Dysfunctions

Has the authority to raise issues and dysfunctions openly

Servant Leader

Is the servant leader for the Scrum Team

Responsibility Influence

Leads through influence

Responsibility Supports PO

Supports the Product Owner by understanding release planning in an empirical environment

Supports Development Team

Supports the Development Team by removing impediments

Supports Organisation

Supports the Organisation by leading coaching during its adoption of Scrum

External Parties

Helps external parties interact with the Scrum Team to maximise the value created

Understanding

Helps the Scrum Team understand the need for clear and precise Product Backlog Items

Facilitation

Facilitates Scrum events as requested or needed

Coaching

Coaches the Scrum team how to self organise and be cross functional

Characteristic Empathy

Uses empathy and compassion to help people solve their problems and satisfy their needs

Characteristic Community

Helps to build a community to improve performance

Transparency

Transparently shows the dysfunctions to an organization

Questioning

Asks honest and open quesitons as a technique to help others solve their problems
